Biography

Franklin Cing Jie Tam is a classical pianist and music educator with international experience across Asia and Central Europe. Born in Indonesia and largely educated in Hong Kong, he holds a Master's degree in Kodály Music Pedagogy from the Liszt Ferenc Academy of Music – Kodály Institute in Hungary, where he graduated with highest honours, following undergraduate music studies at Hong Kong Baptist University.

Known for his versatility as a collaborative pianist across a wide range of styles, Franklin has worked closely with choirs, orchestras, and ensembles in both classical and contemporary repertoires. He has performed at major events and venues including the Hong Kong Cultural Centre, Beijing National Centre for the Performing Arts, and the MRF Praha Music Festival in Prague. In Hong Kong, he served as choir accompanist for the Vienna Boys Choir Music Academy and the Hong Kong Youth Symphonic Orchestra. His training in orchestral and choral conducting has been invaluable in shaping him into a sensitive and responsive accompanist.
